Tell the veteran about yourself: your first name, age, and school you attend. **Please do not include your last name, phone number(s), email address or mailing address.**

## Tips for creating Valentines:

- ★ Tell the veteran why it is important, this year and every year, to celebrate those who serve us in the military.
  - "Thank you for your bravery and courage, because without your courageous acts we may not be here today."
- ★ Include a message.
  - "This valentine is from someone who cares. Thank you for what you did to help our country."
- ★ Write a poem.
  - "A valentine made for someone special, who changed the world for the better; and for that you will always be loved, remembered, and treasured."
